The direct object pronoun *la* means “her,” and also means “it” when replacing a feminine noun that is an object. Just remember that *lo*, *la*, *los*, and *las* refer to both people and things. *Lo* and *la* are also the direct object pronouns for *usted*. So you must consider the gender of the “you” that you are replacing with a pronoun.

Direct Objects and Direct Object Pronouns

Direct Object Pronouns and People. A direct object pronoun can take the place of a direct object referring to a person. In the first sentence below, the direct object is *mi mamá*. It can be replaced by the direct object pronoun *la*, as shown in the second example. examples.

The Spanish direct object pronouns are: me, te, lo, la in the singular, and nos, os, los, las in the plural. The object pronoun usually comes before the verb. Object pronouns are joined to the end of infinitives, gerunds or verbs instructing someone to do something.

EXPLANATION:Direct object pronouns are used to replace direct object nouns. In the first example above, lo is a direct object pronoun that replaces the direct object noun. el vestido. In the second example, las is a direct object pronoun that replaces the direct object noun las camisas.
