A vaccination program should be in place where there is a significant risk of exposure to Hepatitis A or Tetanus (eg workers in regular contact with sewage). The Australian Immunisation Handbook recommends vaccinations for Hepatitis A and Tetanus (as dT or dTpa - ie with Diphtheria +/- Pertussis) for these workers.

Workers handling human waste or sewage should be provided hand washing facilities at the worksite, PPE (described below), and training on how to use this PPE. The training should specifically address methods for the correct and safe removal of PPE to prevent workers from contaminating themselves or others during its removal.
